Adelphoi Education at Altoona Offers:

Adelphoi Education at Altoona is licensed under PDE as a Private Academic School grades K-12. The school provides an academic and therapeutic setting for students from surrounding public school districts who would benefit from a more structured and supportive learning environment. This supportive learning environment is responsive to behavioral and emotional factors that impede students' academic success. Additionally, the school provides treatment to students who have been identified as needing emotional support services or who have experienced a trauma that is making it difficult for the student to cope with daily school functions. Referrals are made directly from the home school district. Altoona offers the following programs: Behavior Support, Emotional Support and Your Educational Success (YES) Credit Recovery/Dropout Prevention Program.

Behavior Support Program

The Behavior Support Program is a temporary placement to assist students in returning students successfully to their home school. This program provides behavior counseling, social skills, and academic instruction in grades 9-12.

Emotional Support Program

The Intensive Behavior Support Program currently has four classrooms (a 1st – 3rd grade classroom, a 4th – 6th grade classroom, a 7th-8th grade, and a 9th- 12th grade classroom). This program is set up the same as the Behavior Support Program but provides therapy from a Licensed Mental Health Therapist on staff.



YES Dropout Prevention Program

The Your Educational Success program, or YES program, assists students to recover credits in order to graduate with their cohort class. Districts using the YES program have a decrease in the number of reported drop outs and an increase in the number of students graduating with their cohort class.


Criteria for Enrollment

Intake criteria are developed in collaboration with the referring school district. Students referred are those who exhibit difficulties in the public school setting due to a variety of reasons, including but not limited to emotional support needs, disruptive behavior, and truancy concerns. Upon referral, an intake meeting will be held with the student, their family, and any support services in place for the student. Other participants include Classroom Teacher(s), School Based Mental Health Therapist, and Administrative Staff. A decision will be made regarding enrollment at the conclusion of the meeting and communicated with the home district and family if the student is a good fit for the program. Student success relies heavily on a collaborative effort of the team, including family cooperation and input. Both regular and special education students are accepted.

Adelphoi Promise

The Adelphoi Promise is an initiative that will facilitate college enrollment and subsequent graduation for current and former Adelphoi youth. The program offers three tiers of assistance: financial support, life skills support, and academic support. Combined, these three facets will provide the best chance for at-risk youth to achieve post-secondary success. The Adelphoi Promise is more than just financial assistance- it offers a firm hand to guide youth through the process of making post-secondary education a reality. The Adelphoi Promise offers up to two years of tuition-free education at an affiliated community college, financial assistance for books, a refurbished laptop computer, when applicable, guidance and support.
